How to become 501c3

Follow these steps to form your own nonprofit 501(c)(3) corporation.

1. Choose a name. ...
2. **File** articles of incorporation. ...
3. Apply for your IRS tax exemption. ...
4. Apply for a state tax exemption. ...
5. Draft bylaws. ...
6. Appoint directors. ...
7. Hold a meeting of the board. ...
8. Obtain licenses and permits.

This is a state-level process that establishes a *nonprofit*, corporate entity by the filing of Articles of Incorporation. ... To obtain 501(c)(3) status, a *nonprofit* corporation must apply to the Internal Revenue Service for recognition of tax exemption by filing IRS *Form* 1023.

Could I be both 501c3 and LLC?

Use of an **LLC** by a **Nonprofit**. ... In this case, the **LLC** will not be tax-exempt. To operate a joint venture with one or more other entities. The **LLC** housing the joint venture **may** be tax-exempt if all of its members are tax-exempt or taxable if its members consist of **both nonprofit** and for-profit organizations. Aug 28, 2014
