

S.C. SENATE



- 46 members currently 45 1 vacancy
- 28 Republicans and 17 Democrats currently
- Four year terms 2016 is election year for all
- Of 45 current members, 10 were new in 2013;
 1 new in 2014; and 1 new in 2015
- 7 Republicans and 5 Democrats

State Senate District 0024



Senate District 24



- Part of downtown Aiken, South Aiken, Warrenville, Gloverville, Couchton, Montmorenci, Windsor, New Ellenton, Jackson, Beech Island, and North Augusta
- District 24 has about 100,000 based on 2010 census

2014 – Dept. of Commerce



- 19,020 jobs recruited
- \$5.088 Billion in recruited capital investment
- 146 announced recruited projects
 - -- 57% expansions
 - -- 43% new
- Medac North Augusta -- #5 615 jobs

2014 – Dept. of Commerce

- NAS STATE OF SOUTH CAROL
- Home to 4 of top 10 global tire manufacturers
- 89,000 tires made daily
- From 2011 -2014, manufacturing employment grew 13.5% -- tops in Southeast
- Ranked 1st in exports of finished cars to the world – vehicles are state's top export commodity

Commerce – Small Business



- Direct assistance 767 companies in 40 counties
- Buy South Carolina 387 businesses registered – 12/31/14
- Lender matchmaking events
- State Trade and Export Promotion program
 - helped 62 small companies enter international markets

SC – Small Business



- 97% of employers in state are less than 100 employees
- Employ half of state's private workforce in 2011
- Top 3 accommodation and food services; health care; and retail trade

Work Force Development



- Tech system, DEW, & Commerce partner Ready SC and Apprenticeship Carolina
- Aiken County is working toward certification one more step

Commerce – Pro Business



- 5% corporate income tax rate
- No state property tax
 - Local level fee in lieu
- No local income tax
- No inventory tax
- No sales tax on manufacturing equipment, industrial power or materials for finished products
- No unitary tax on worldwide profits
- Utilizes BuySC program for SC vendors and buyers

Angel Investor Act



- Enacted in 2013
- Tax credits to angel investors
- Up to 35% of qualified investment
- SC Secretary of State has guidelines on website
