- > Start an LLC

Why do I need an LLC?

- Protect yourself
- Protect your brand
- Impact on taxes
- Open bank accounts
- Enter contracts
- Get business licenses and permits

PROPOSED NEW RULE - HERE WE GO AGAIN

Totality of the Circumstances Test

- (1) Worker's opportunity for profit or loss
- (2) Investment by worker and employer
- (3) Permanence
- (4) Nature and degree of control over the work
- (5) Integral part
- (6) Skill and Initiative

RESULT: More workers are employees

Why is that important?



COMMENTS/CONCERNS WITH NEW RULE

Do not capture the American workforce

Impact on gig workers

Impact on small or micro business

Administrative burden to businesses



HOW TO PROTECT YOURSELF

FIRST

- > Examine what you need worker to do
- Length of time for proposed work
- Control over work
- Look at Totality Factors

THEN

- > Have a good independent contractor agreement
- > Encourage EIN/LLC if worker does not have
- Business Cards
